

Compañía Financiera Argentina in US\$34.5 million debt offering

Argentina's Estudio Beccar Varela has acted as deal counsel for financial services company Compañía Financiera Argentina's US\$34.5 million notes issuance.

The notes, which form part of the financial services provider's US\$250 million global programme, were issued in two series on 26 September. Banco de Galicia y Buenos Aires and Standard Bank Argentina acted as both organisers and placement agents.

The series I notes were issued at a nominal value of 49 million Argentine pesos (US\$10.5 million) and the series II notes were issued for 112 million Argentine pesos (US\$24 million).

The notes were listed on The Buenos Aires Stock Exchange and have been admitted to trading on the Mercado Abierto Electrónico.

In May Beccar Varela helped Compañía Financiera raise US\$34.2 million as part of the same global notes programme.
