

Beccar Varela promotes two in banking and labour

Argentina's **Estudio Beccar Varela** has boosted its partnership to 25 with the addition of two lawyers as full partners in its banking and labour departments.

Pablo José Torretta, 40, has experience in banking law and financial and exchange regulation, while Álvaro Galli, 36, focuses his practice on labour and social security law. Both lawyers joined the firm in 2001 and were promoted to partner on 31 October.

Estudio Beccar Varela says the new additions to the partnership are in recognition of the “outstanding talent” of both lawyers and the “tremendous contribution” they have made to their respective practice areas.

While a junior partner, Torretta was part of the team to **advise** Citibank as indenture and collateral trustee on Aeropuertos Argentina 2000's milestone bond issuance worth US\$300 million in 2010 and also **assisted** the Argentine branch of Brazilian bank Itaú in a joint loan programme with Brazilian development bank BNDES to help Argentine investors buy Brazilian capital goods the same year.

Galli also began to make a name for himself while a junior partner and was singled out as one to **watch** by his peers in Argentina's labour field earlier this year.
