

Beccar Varela celebrates 120 years with re-branding

One of Argentina's largest and oldest firms, Beccar Varela, has celebrated turning 120 years-old.

The firm opened in 1897 and today has 27 partners and 145 lawyers. To coincide with its anniversary, which took place on 8 July, it has rebranded, dropping Estudio from its name. The firm now goes by Beccar Varela. It has also designed an updated logo.

On 22 August the firm hired associate Dorothea Garff to staff its German desk. The department is led by partner Miguel Remmer. Garff draws on experience working for the Argentine-German Chamber of Industry and Commerce.
