Arla Foods finds whey to fund Córdoba plant

The Argentine branch of Danish whey producer Arla Foods Ingredients has obtained a US\$56 million loan from the International Finance Corporation (IFC) to expand its production plant in the northern Argentine city of Córdoba.

The company hired Marval, O'Farrell & Mairal in Buenos Aires for the transaction, while the IFC turned to Clifford Chance LLP in Washington, DC and Argentina's Estudio Beccar Varela.

The Argentine branch of Arla Foods is a joint venture between its Danish parent company and Argentine dairy producer SanCor. The company <u>obtained</u> a US\$22 million loan to expand its Córdoba factory from Germany's Deutscher Investitions-und Entwicklungsgesellschaft and the Netherlands' Rabobank in 2008.

The transaction closed on 18 September.
