

Beccar Varela and Basílico Santurio in milling company loan

Argentina's Basílico Santurio & Andrada Abogados has helped local wheat and oilseed milling company Molino Cañuelas obtain a 200 million Argentine peso (US\$38 million) loan from a syndicate of banks.

Estudio Beccar Varela advised the banks: Banco Itaú Argentina, Industrial and the Commercial Bank of China (Argentina), Banco Hipotecario and HSBC Bank Argentina. The deal was made public on 4 June.

Molino Cañuelas will use the facility to boost its working capital in Argentina's agribusiness sector.
